
Structure and Governance

- A Mirror Group
- The working groups
- The members (General Assembly)

The European Commission (DG MARE, DG Research as leader, DG Enterprise, DG Environment and DG for Health and Consumers should be associated



Board of Directors (BoD)




The mission: taking forward and consolidating the "vision" of the EFTP and ensuring the Platforms' relevance.

Stimulating the mobilization of all major stakeholders.


1 Chairperson and 2 Vice-chairpersons FROM INDUSTRY



Steering Group (SG)




- Key element of EFTP -----put he strategies into practice.
- SG will comprise at least:
 - •One representative of each of the organizations that form part of the **BOD**.
 - Representatives of the Mirror Group.
 - •The Chairpersons of the Working Groups.
- With assistance of the <u>Technical Secretariat</u>
- The main deliverables consist in:
 - (1) Strategic Research Agenda (SRA)
 - (2) Lighthouse projects
 - (3) Policy interface, or framework, and business development initiatives
 - (4) Action plans for the various technical and non-technical issues.



Steering Group (SG)




- **Proposals** for an efficient platform governance.
- •An **action plan** scheduling the main lines of activity and indicative timing of the platform deliverables.
- Procedures for monitoring and quality assurance of platform operations.
- •Annual reports on platform progress, including a non-technical section to inform policy-makers and the general public.




Mirror Group (MG)

Represents the **interests and views of the MS** and provides responses from such perspective to the recommendations and actions of EFTP

Promotes an enhances co-operation and coordination among MS and European activities: Explores mechanisms for developing synergies.





"To assess opportunities for collaboration with other on going Technology Platforms avoiding overlapped activities and exploring synergies"

Working Groups (WGs)



The mandate of the WGs shall be decided by the BOD.

"The WGs are **widely free** to choose their members and internal structure. However, they have to elect a chairperson and a facilitator from the group"

Activities may include:

- The drawing-up of roadmaps in the various technology thematic areas.
- Provide input to the Strategic Research Agenda.
- The assessment on options for funding instruments, mechanisms and structures under FP7 including the suggestion of projects.

- •The addressing of issues related to the research infrastructure, including centers of excellence/competence.
- •The focus on the various non-technical aspects of innovation, standardization, IPR, marketing issues and other horizontal aspects
- Human resources issues.
- •Regular meetings will be held involving members of the other Working Groups



Technical Secretariat

- Organisational and operational support to all the components and levels of the EFTP structure.
- Suggest working methods for meetings and collectively yield documents
- Information and Communication Strategy implementation.
- Support and assessment on horizontal aspects relevant for the platform's objectives.
- Organization of events (partic. the Platform's Annual Conference).
- The TS should facilitate, administration and information and communication functions.
- It should maintain a strictly neutral position regarding policy setting and orientation of final documents and deliverables of the Platform.


